<u>SEPTEMBER AWAY TRIP TO BUNDABERG</u> <u>departing 29th September 2024</u>

Hello travelling enthusiasts, well I promised a number of members that I would present another away trip for the latter part of the year and to this end I will take expressions of interest for our latest bus trip spectacular at our May meeting.

The proposed trip will take 5 days and 4 nights travelling to Bundaberg Maryborough and surrounds. The itinerary takes us to both famous and out of the way venues and includes a beautiful boat trip on the Burnett River and internationally recognised whale watching in Hervey Bay.

This bus trip is again provided by Allan Foster of Granite Highlands Maxi-tours, whose costings I believe to be extremely reasonable in this world of escalating prices. To be fair to all members I will take the names of those members wishing to go on the away trip on a first come basis at the May meeting and not prior to or by telephone.

The itinerary is included in this edition of the newsletter and is costed at \$1369 per person for double/ twin accommodation and \$1709 for single accommodation. Payment will consist of a deposit of \$100 per person by our June meeting and the final payment of the outstanding amount by the August meeting.

If the proposed bus trip receives adequate support at the May meeting this outing which is set down for Sunday 29th September 2024 will proceed. I continually strive to bring the best of away trips for you and I know this one wont disappoint.

Branch Refund Policy

Cancellation of an outing
